Remember...

If you are not chosen for Student Staff after these interviews, again, do not take it as a failure. YOU DO NOT NEED AN OFFICIAL TITLE TO MAKE A POSITIVE DIFFERENCE WITHIN THE BAND!

Here are some things to keep in mind about the interviews, as well as some tips and tricks:

- Interviews will take place on Monday, May 16th promptly at 4:00pm in Mr. Encina's office. As you can see on the list below, Monday is going to be a long day for interviews. You do not need to check in with anyone at a certain time, but just make sure you are prompt and present to go while the person previous to you is interviewing. The remaining interviews will take place on Tuesday, May 17th promptly at 3:30pm in Mr. Encina's office.
- **BE READY TO BE ASKED ANYTHING!** You may be asked some hard-hitting questions, so be prepared.
- **DRESS TO IMPRESS!** When interviewing for any type of position, it's always best to present yourself as best as possible.
- **BREATHE BEFORE YOU ENTER!** You can't always control your nerves, but you can work to keep it from growing out of control.
- **KEEP YOUR ANSWERS SUCCINCT AND STRAIGHT TO THE POINT!** Nerves can sometimes cause interviewees to talk endlessly without much of a point. But a short and sweet answer displays confidence and knowingness.

RAISERIGHT & SHOP WITH SCRIP

The Booster Board is excited to announce a new, on-going fundraiser!

RaiseRight & Shop With Scrip is a program where individuals buy gift cards from hundreds of participating companies and the LOHS Band, Orchestra and Color Guard program will get a % of the sale directly from the participating companies.

Scrip is an easy and convenient way to raise money for the program, just by buying gift cards for items you already spend money on. There are grocery store gift cards, restaurant gift cards, department and hardware store gift cards, entertainment gift cards and so many more!

Buy groceries at Albertsons? Use Albertsons scrip!

Do you have Hulu? Pay your bill with scrip!

Love Starbucks? Buy Starbucks scrip!

Doing some Amazon Shopping? Amazon scrip is available!

Working on home repairs? Get some Home Depot scrip before you head over!

Can't decide what to give family and friends as birthday and holiday gifts? Consider gift cards!

Do you have friends and family members that would love to support the music program but live out of town and can't purchase fundraising products? Do they want to support the program, but don't necessarily need what we sell in our other fundraisers? Scrip is perfect for them too!

Everyone can participate in scrip – parents, guardians, grandparents, aunts and uncles, relatives, friends, neighbors, alumni – anyone! Raising funds through scrip can occur anywhere in the country and all year long! It is as simple as setting up an account and buying gift cards. Scrip can be used for in-store and online purchases.

Individuals order and pay for scrip gift cards online through their website or through the RaiseRight mobile app and gift cards are digitally delivered directly to the buyer's e-wallet. Both Android and iOS devices are supported. RaiseRight & Shop With Scrip sends their contribution directly to the Band Boosters. It's as easy as that!

In addition, over 250 brands of gift cards are available in a physical format and can be shipped through the mail. Shipping fees do apply.

In an effort to eliminate shipping fees for physical cards, once a quarter, we will offer group purchases with shipping to the Band Boosters directly, thus eliminating the individual shipping cost to buyers. Those purchases will have to be ordered, paid for and picked up through the Band Booster organization. Once this part of the program is up and running, details will be provided as to how to make those purchases. We plan to have that option ready to launch within the next month.

Scrip can be used for Fair Share fundraising. Families that use scrip for fair share fundraising will receive **50%** of the revenue received from RaiseRight & Shop With Scrip towards the student's fair share contribution and 50% will go to support the general fund. Families that elect to use scrip for fair share will need to communicate that to the scrip coordinator so that we can track the revenue we receive to the correct student. Families can raise a significant amount of funds by encouraging family members and friends to set up accounts and participate. Band, Orchestra and Color Guard program families will need to communicate to our scrip coordinator the names of all individuals that sign up to participate on their behalf so we can direct funds generated from those individuals into the correct students' accounts. Families can still choose to make fair share contributions out of pocket and have all of the proceeds from their scrip purchases go to the general fund to help pay for program expenses.

Please use our new scrip email address, lohsbandboostersscrip@gmail.com to communicate the names of any participant accounts you want credited to your child.

As an incentive for families to sign up for the program – 75% of the revenue from scrip sales for January and February 2022 will go to the fair share contribution for those that request it.

Different companies pay different percentages to the program and some companies offer “extra percentage sales” from time to time so individual student revenue amounts will vary. Families will need to communicate with our financial secretary to inquire about individual student balances in their scrip account.

Information about how to get started, set up an account and buy scrip are shared in separate documents. Transaction fees do apply and are explained in the *Shop With Scrip Basics* document. You can share these documents with family and friends as well.

In order to join, individuals will need the **program name**: Los Osos Band Boosters
and the **Program Code**: RHFME8GFVFDW

Allow 3-4 days for the set-up process to be activated before being able to purchase scrip.

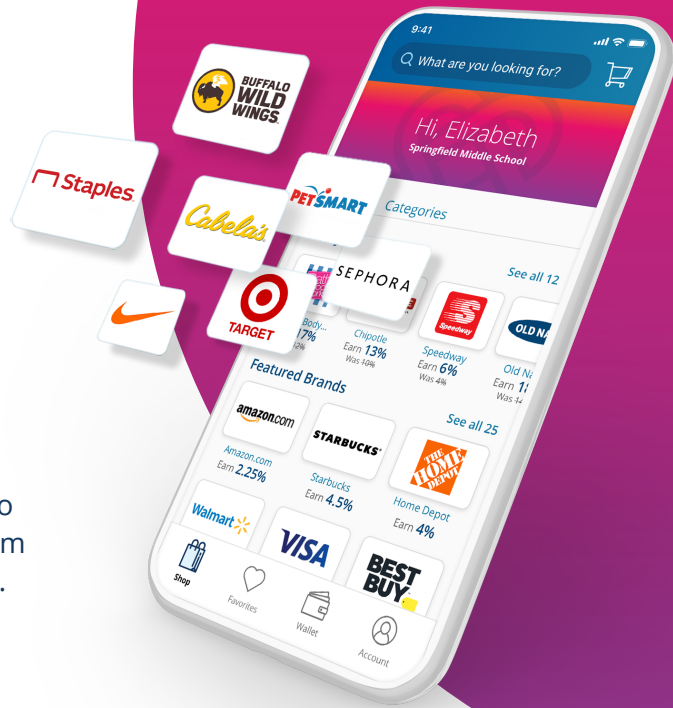

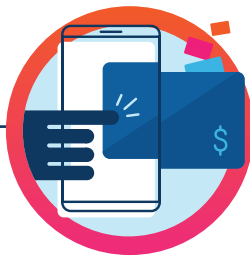

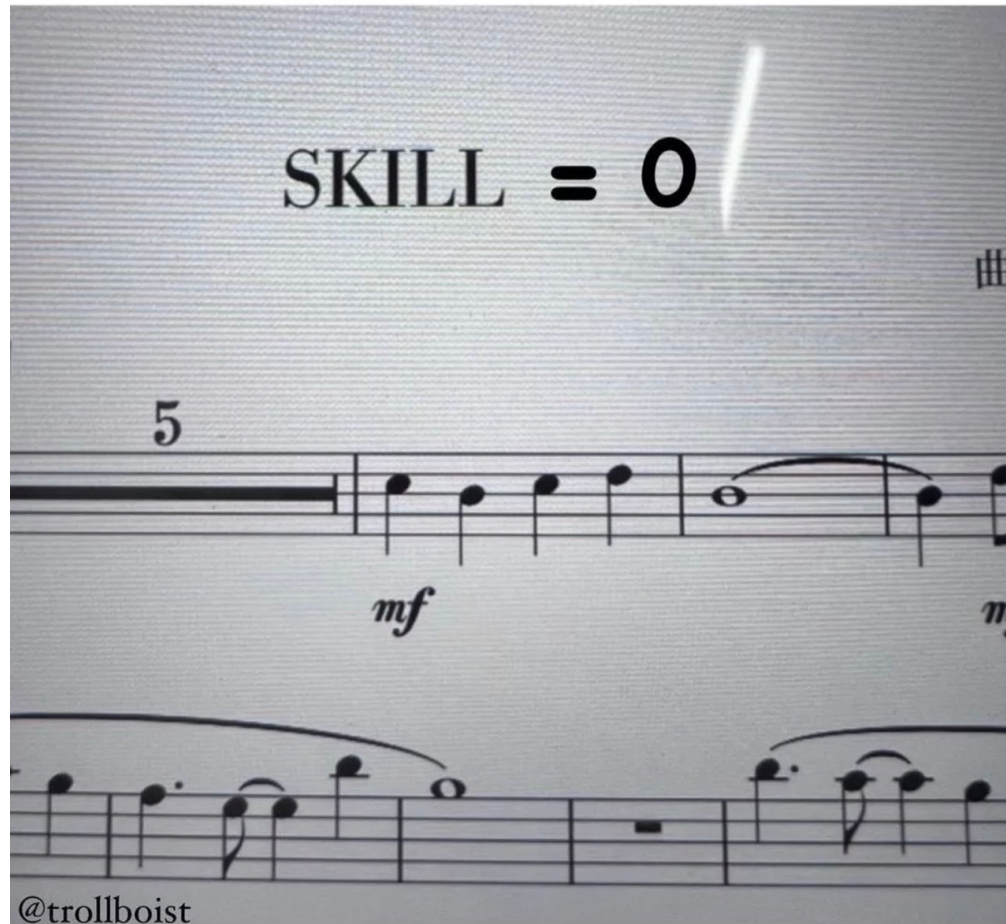
